

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING POSTPONEMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of Alderman of the Village of Tiki Island of Galveston County, Texas desires to implement the following postponement of the May 2, 2020 General Election:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE VILLAGE OF TIKI ISLAND THAT:

Section 1: The Village of Tiki Island has ordered a General Election on May 2, 2020 for the purpose of electing three (3) Alderman.

Section 2: Pursuant to Section 418.016 of the Texas Government Code the Governor has issued a proclamation suspending certain provisions of the Texas Election Code and the Texas Water Code to allow all local political subdivisions that are utilizing the May 2, 2020 uniform election date to postpone their election to the November 3, 2020 uniform election date in the best interest of the public in regards to the COVID-19 crisis.

Section 3: The Board of Alderman hereby exercises the authority to postpone the May 2, 2020 General Election until November 3, 2020.

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of the Village of the Blind in Garzon County, Texas desires to
implement the following postponement of the May 2, 2020 General Election:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE VILLAGE OF
THE BLIND THAT:

Section 1. The Village of the Blind shall order a General Election on May 2, 2020 for the purpose
of electing three (3) Aldermen.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 18 (b) of the Texas Government Code, the Board has found a
substantial emergency exists in that the Texas State Board of Election Administration has
found public health conditions that require the May 2, 2020 election to be postponed. The
Board of the Village of the Blind has found that the public interest in the Village of the Blind
requires the postponement of the May 2, 2020 election to November 2, 2020.

Section 3. The Board of Aldermen hereby certifies the authority to postpone the May 2, 2020
General Election until November 2, 2020.

Section 4. The certified copies of this Resolution shall be filed with the County Clerk.


Section 6: The following dates apply for the November 3, 2020 General Election:

Section 7: This Order constitutes official action by the Board of Alderman of the Village of Tiki Island.


