

**MAYOR'S TEMPORARY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1**  
**Village of Tiki Island, Texas**

**WHEREAS**, on March 19, 2020, I, Vernon "Goldie" Teltschick, the Mayor of the Village of Tiki Island, Texas, exercised my authority under Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code to declare a local state of disaster for the Village of Tiki Island, Texas (the "City") because of the current COVID-19 pandemic;

**WHEREAS**, on March 26, 2020, the Governor of Texas issued an order mandating that people traveling to Texas from certain locations by air be subject to a 14 day quarantine;

**WHEREAS**, on March 27, 2020, the City Council of the Village of Tiki Island passed an ordinance consenting to an extension of my declaration of a local state of disaster until April 27, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, on March 29, 2020, the Governor of Texas issued a proclamation adding additional locations to his order requiring that people traveling to Texas from certain locations by air be subject to a 14-day self quarantine;

**WHEREAS**, on March 29, 2020, the Governor of Texas issued an order mandating that people entering Texas through roadways from Louisiana be subject to a 14-day self quarantine.

**WHEREAS**, as Mayor, I have authority under Section 418.108 (g) of the Texas Government Code, to control the movement of persons and the occupancy of premises within the City during a declared state of disaster;

**WHEREAS**, there is a risk that people from areas that are experiencing high levels of COVID-19 infections will travel to the City and spread the virus among its inhabitants;

**WHEREAS**, the availability within the City of premises that are offered for short term rental increases the likelihood that people from outside the City, who may have been exposed to COVID-19, will travel to the City;

**WHEREAS**, the imposition of temporary restrictions on the use of premises for short-term rentals and the City's cooperation and support in the enforcement of the governor's orders requiring mandatory self-quarantine of certain travelers is necessary to protect public health and safety;


**FOR THE REASONS STATED I HEREBY ORDER THAT:**


**Section 1.** The use of premises within the City for rental for residential purposes, for periods of thirty days or less, is prohibited while this Executive Order remains in effect.

**Section 2.** The City shall support the enforcement of the Governor's executive orders mandating self-quarantine for people traveling by air or road from locations designated in those orders, and I authorize City staff to provide any lawful cooperation and assistance in the enforcement of those orders as may be necessary to protect the public health and safety.

**Section 3.** This Executive Order No. 1 shall remain in effect and in full force while the declaration of a state of disaster in the City continues in effect, unless earlier modified, amended, rescinded or superseded.

**Section 4.** I hereby direct City staff to take steps to notify the public of this order and see that it is given prompt and general publicity and to see that the City Secretary promptly files the original of this Order in the City's official records.
